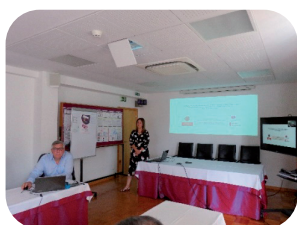


Figure 1. International seminars for researchers' training

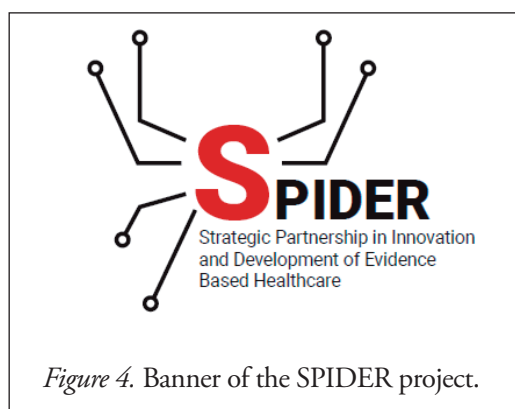


Figure 4. Banner of the SPIDER project.

Objectives: To decrease the gap between research and practice in healthcare and support the international cooperation of professionals in healthcare. To address the needs of improving skills and qualifications of European project partners in Evidence-Based Health Care and critical thinking, especially in the translation/implementation and use of evidence in healthcare clinical practice.

Duration: 24 months (1. 9. 2019 – 31. 8. 2021)

Partners: Czech Republic (Applicant organization), Portugal (PCEBP/UICISA: E/ESEnfC), Romania (Ordinul Asistentilor Medicali Generalisti, Moaselor Si Asistentilor Medicali Din Romania-Filiala Bucuresti), Spain (Instituto de Salud Carlos III), and United Kingdom (Cardiff University)

Project outcomes relevant for PCEBP: 4 members of PCEBP with the JBI Evidence-based Clinical Fellowship Program (EBCFP) and 4 Best Practice Implementation Projects in Portugal.

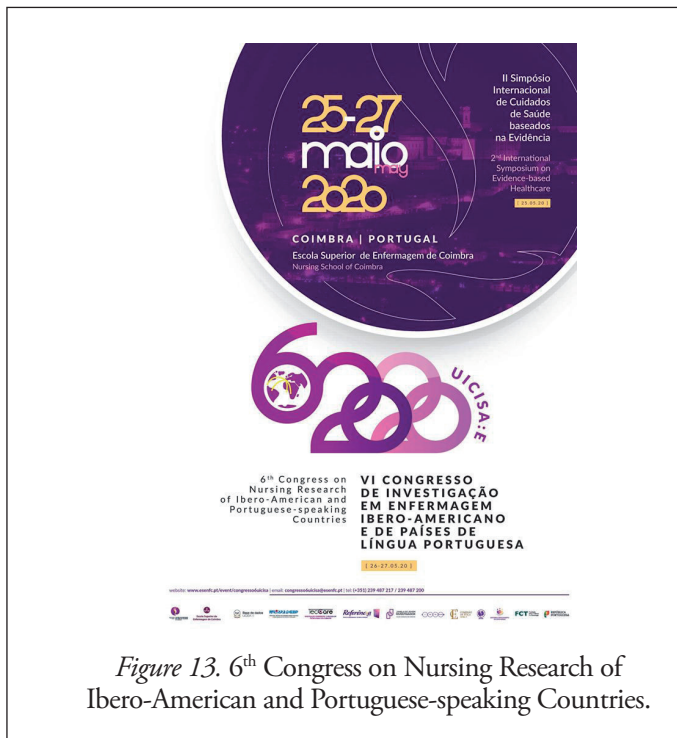


Figure 13. 6th Congress on Nursing Research of Ibero-American and Portuguese-speaking Countries.
