The paper should be structured according to the following sections.

### **Title**

- It is limited to 16 words
- In Portuguese, English, and Spanish

### **Abstract**

- It is limited to 170 words
- It identifies the context
- It identifies the objectives
- It identifies the methodology
- It identifies the results
- It includes a conclusion
- In Portuguese, English, and Spanish
- Without citations

### **Keywords**

- The article is limited to 6 keywords, presented according to the MeSH (Medical Subject Headings)/ DeCS (Descritores em Ciências da Saúde) descriptors.

### **Introduction**

- It describes the crucial steps involved in the writing
- It provides context for a historical research topic
- It presents the relevance of the study
- It presents the main objective(s)

### **Methodology**

- It explains the nature of the historical sources used

- It explains the location of the historical sources used
- It presents the treatment and analysis process of the study's sources
- It provides information about the study's approval by an Ethics Committee and indicates the opinion's code if applicable

**Results and Discussion** (the historical narrative is the final part of the historical research process, in which the researcher, based on data interpretation, explains what happened, how, and why it happened).

- It presents a chronological sequence of the facts regarding the topic addressed
- It highlights the study's new and essential aspects/elements
- It shows the relevance of the references used to discuss the results
- It highlights the dialogue with the international scientific community
- It demonstrates the study's contributions to the development of new knowledge

### **Conclusion**

- The study's conclusions align with the objectives and are supported by the results

### **References**

- Maximum of 30 references; at least 80% should be from articles in journals indexed in international databases and from the last three years
