The paper should be structured according to the following sections.

Title
 □ It is limited to 16 words □ In Portuguese, English, and Spanish
Abstract
 □ It is limited to 170 words □ It identifies the background □ It identifies the objectives □ It identifies the main topics under analysis □ It includes a conclusion □ In Portuguese, English, and Spanish □ Without citations
Keywords
☐ The article is limited to 6 keywords, presented according to the MeSH (Medical Subject Headings)/ DeCS (Descritores em Ciências da Saúde) descriptors
Introduction
 □ It defines the theoretical issue to be discussed □ It explains the motives and relevance of the issue □ It provides a context to the issue in terms of the existing knowledge □ It specifies the procedures and sources used □ It describes the objectives of the study
Development
 □ It presents the contents in a logical sequence □ It develops ideas in a critical way consistent with the defined objectives □ The arguments are substantiated in a coherent way







☐ The arguments presented are relevant and appropriate to the context
☐ The statements comply with ethical and legal principles
$\hfill\square$ It summarises what is new about the article in relation to what was already known
Conclusion
☐ It presents a conclusive synthesis
☐ It identifies the contribution of the article to the existing knowledge in a specific field
☐ It alludes to the implications/recommendations found for both theory/practice and research

\square Maximum of 30 references; at least 80% should be from articles in journals indexed in international databases and from the last three years
